Methodology

Constructed by applying Generation5's Mathematical Technologies™, Generation5's G5 Super Census micro marketing database provides unprecedented refinement in demographic and socio-economic data. G5 Super Census is comprised of Census variables modeled at the postal code level.

Generation5 performs a set of complex calculations based on several integrated data inputs, and on derived geographic linkages, in order to model Census variables at the postal code level. The advanced mathematical technology applied to create G5 Super Census involves techniques employing the theory of machine learning using several integrated data inputs as a training set. In particular, a scenario based, non-parametric, non-linear approach is adopted. G5 Super Census is produced using a sophisticated set of proprietary data-mining technologies, including a feature-selection/data-reduction module (VIVa) and a prediction/classification module (MWM).

Generation5's innovative Feature Selection methodology automatically selects the most relevant features (independent variables), eliminates erroneous and redundant features and significantly improves the accuracy of subsequent prediction algorithms.

Generation5's proprietary prediction methodologies are sophisticated algorithms that generate estimates for a target (dependent) variable based on a historical record, and a set of independent variables.
